Budelicious Photographic Competition 2019

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. BATB (Bude Area Tourist Board) already promotes the town with amazing images of the scenery of beaches, boats, canal, cliffs and countryside. This competition is called "*Bude at work, rest or play*" and invites you to enter images of local people who "*prepare and serve our delicious food and drink or serve our community in other ways*". We are looking for the best photographs capturing that perfect 'Bude at work, rest or play' moment. We are looking for beautiful images that capture the skills, care and concentration of Bude locals: from a chef making a dish to a lifeguard on the beach, from church bell ringer to the Bude town band; from lobster fishers to people opening the lock gates, from making local cheeses to the carnival, from making a pasty to the Blessing of the Sea. These are just examples; the theme is open to your personal interpretation.
2. The decisions of Budelicious, BATB/Visit Bude, hereafter called "The Organizers" and their judges will be final and no correspondence can be entered into.
3. Photographs entered must be taken in Bude or immediate surrounding area.
4. Entrants may submit up to three photographs, in colour, which must be emailed in JPEG format, no larger than 4 Mbyte each to The Organizers at budeliciousphoto@gmail.com. The email must list "Bude at work, rest or play - Photography Competition 2019" in the Subject line. Each photo file must be named as follows: photographer's family name#photographer's initial#title of image.jpeg.

5. Digital photography does allow for some image enhancement to remove spots, scratches etc. You may enhance the image to improve its composition, but multiple or collage images will not be accepted and we want you to stay faithful to the spirit of the competition and never misrepresent the scene being portrayed. The judges reserve the right to exclude any image they believe may be excessively treated so as to alter its authenticity.
6. Employees of The Organizers, Falcon Hotel/Budelicious, BATB/Visit Bude, as well as their immediate family are not eligible to enter the competition. Entrants under the age of 16 need the consent of a parent or guardian to enter.

7. Each entry must be identified by the photographer's name, photo title, address, contact telephone number and age. The location of the photograph, the date the photo was shot, and a short description of the moment (up to 50 words) must also be included.
8. The Organizers/Budelicious will only ever use your personal details for the purposes of administering the competition and will only keep your personal details as long as is necessary to fulfil these purposes. The Organizers/Budelicious will not pass on your personal information to a third party without your prior permission. The Organizers/Budelicious abide by the General Data Protection Regulations of 2018 and comply with its provisions to ensure that any data you provide are treated accordingly.
9. The competition closes at midnight on Wednesday 31 August 2019 and entries received after this date will not be considered. Entries will not be returned so please remember to keep a copy. Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted and no feedback on any entry will be provided. A short list of finalists will be published and displayed at the Budelicious Food Festival, September 20/21/22 and the winner will be announced during that weekend.
10. The winner will receive £200 cash plus one night's accommodation for two people, including breakfast and a Champagne Dinner at the Falcon Hotel, total value £500. The winner and runners-up may have their image displayed on the Budelicious and Visit Bude websites and may feature in other marketing and promotions to help us show off our town's people. The prize cannot be deferred or transferred. There will be no cash alternative for the hotel accommodation. The Falcon Hotel alone is responsible for the prizes.
11. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence can be entered into.
12. All entries must be the original work of the entrant, and must not infringe the rights of any other party. Each entrant must be the sole owner of copyright in all photographs entered and must have obtained permission of any Persons or Property featured in the entries or permission of their parents/guardians if children under the age of 16 are featured. See Forms attached. The photographer must seek permission and be prepared to provide written consent, if requested. Further, entrants must not have breached any laws when taking their photographs. 13. Entrants will retain copyright in the photographs that they submit to the Budelicious “Bude at work, rest or play” Photography Competition. By entering the said Competition all entrants grant the right to publish and exhibit their photographs on the Organizers’ websites and other marketing activities in perpetuity both nationally and globally. Entrants whose photographs are submitted grant The Organizers (Budelicious/BATB/Visit Bude) the further rights to publish and exhibit their photographs in print, in any other media in perpetuity. No fees will be payable for any of the above uses. While we make every effort to credit photographers, including in printed reproductions of their work, we cannot guarantee that every use of the photographs will include photographers’ names.

14. The Organizers reserve the right to cancel the competition or alter any of the rules at any stage, if deemed necessary in their opinion, and if circumstances arise beyond their control.
